Paragraph 1

In the Memorandum of Understanding for Establishment of the Public Administration Reform Fund between the UK Department for International Development, the Swedish Agency for International Development Cooperation, the Netherlands Ministry for Development Cooperation, the Delegation of the European Union in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Council of Ministers of BiH, the Government of the Federation of BiH, the Government of the Republic of Srpska, the Government of the Brčko District and the Ministry of Finance and Treasury of BiH in the introductory paragraphs in the Item 1 at the end of the sentence the full stop shall be replaced by a comma and the text shall be added as follows, “and bearing in mind that the rights and obligations of the UK Department for International Development (DFID) for the period January 1st, 2011 to December 31st, 2011 shall be assumed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Great Britain”.

Paragraph 2

In the paragraph 3 in item 19, in the first sentence, the number 2010 shall be replaced by the number 2011.


